SUMMARY OF FUNCTIONS

This position is responsible for planting trees, shrubs and seedlings through both the CVC Naturalization and Reforestation programs and assists with the collection of forest inventory data on Authority properties. This position also supports the production and maintenance of tree and shrub stock and other duties as assigned. These positions will be based out of the CVC Terra Cotta Conservation Area Workshop just north of the village of Terra Cotta.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Post-secondary studies in Forestry, Horticulture, Natural Resource Management, Environmental Science or Biology is preferred
- Outdoor work experience in landscaping, nursery operation, tree planting or forestry
- Experience with the safe operation of farm and landscape equipment
- Experience in the collection of field data
- Tree and shrub identification skills an asset.
- Valid class "G" Ontario Drivers License required
- All candidates should have access to reliable transportation
- Candidates should be prepared for outdoor work away from amenities on a daily basis

- Working as part of a team planting reforestation seedlings, shrubs and trees in various natural environments on public and private lands
- Nursery duties include but is not limited to: potting, watering, weeding, and general care of nursery stock
- Safe operation of mechanical equipment including: farm tractors, weed trimmer, ATV, water pumps, loading trailers
- Collecting forest inventory data to update CVC forest management plans
- Conducting work in a safe manner, ensuring that all CVC health and safety policies and procedures are adhered to at all times
